- Communicates regularly with students about postsecondary options
- Offers a website where students, families, and caregivers can access ASPIRE and CCR information and resources
- Requests OSAC/ASPIRE presentations
- Requests OSAC/ASPIRE and ECMC publications

Equity and Student Support

- ASPIRE Coordinators receive training on supporting undocumented/DACA students-★
- ASPIRE Coordinators receive training on supporting underrepresented students-★
- All college access presentations include information for undocumented/DACA students
- Training provided for staff/mentors to assist undocumented/ DACA students
- Email/print communication to students are commonly offered in 2+ languages
- CCR presentations are translated
- Collaborate with counselors, teachers, and student clubs to promote college for underserved populations
- Collaborate with parent groups to promote equity in college access

Staff and Site Partner Engagement

- Staff is aware and supportive of the ASPIRE program and CCR work-★
- ASPIRE Coordinator attends ASPIRE fall conference and regional meeting
- Site CCR staff/partners are invited to attend ASPIRE conference and webinars
- ASPIRE/CCR is included in school's strategic plan
- Counselors partner with ASPIRE Coordinator
- Counselors & teachers refer students to ASPIRE
- Teachers, admin, and staff talk about their college and/or job experiences in the classroom
- Teachers incorporate CCR activities into core lessons (i.e., English: personal narrative admissions essay)
- Teachers collaborate with ASPIRE/college centers to provide information in classes
- Site staff are invited to be ASPIRE mentors
