Academic performance and meeting minimum qualifications are not the sole criteria for admission to an OUS university. A university may evaluate an applicants' behavior and background to determine their ability to maintain the standards of academic and professional conduct expected at the university. An evaluation may take into consideration current behavior and performance as well as past experiences and actions.
