Overview

- Before meeting with students, community mentors are **required** to complete a background check form provided by the site coordinator.
- Mentors and students must meet:
 - $_{\circ}$ $\,$ on-site, unless otherwise decided with site coordinator $\,$
 - o during operating hours
 - in the presence of paid staff
- Mentors may not transport students in personal vehicles.
- Mentors should avoid conflicts of interest (e.g., promoting personal religious or political beliefs, selling to students, etc.).

Confidentiality

Mentors, upon signing the Mentor Agreement, agree to keep all student information private and confidential. This includes:

- Financial information
- College applications
- Scholarship applications
- Transcripts
- Personal identity and contact information

Site Safety Protocol

All ASPIRE mentors should be aware of the site's safety measures and policies, including:

- Bell system
- Lockdown procedures
- First aid resources
- Infection control
- Fire extinguisher locations
- Weapons policy

Mandatory Reporting

All community mentors working with Oregon youth are considered mandatory reporters; cases of suspected child abuse and neglect must be reported. For questions about mandatory reporting visit the <u>Oregon Department of Human Service</u> website.
