Ongoing events/ideas for your ASPIRE/College & Career Center:

- Career/industry presenters (consider partnering with CTE/core class teachers & then offer to general students interested)
- Identify times of your day specifically for student appointment times (in person/video) with Outlook/signup genius/etc.
- Social Media/Website development
- Lunchtime workshops/seminars
- Encourage students to use your center when on releases going home they often get little done and are distracted
- Job shadow, informational interview & mock interview opportunities

Coordinator Self-care

- Don't think you have to do this alone ask for help, use ASPIRE/OSAC resources
- Identify collaborators in your building that you can go to for help/assistance or to listen
- Identify your priorities (with the help of your ASPIRE Access Specialist & site administrator) and do those things well before adding more to your plate
- Leave work at work
