

# IS OREGON PROMISE FOR YOU?

## Oregon Promise Helps Pay for Community College



Oregon Promise is a state grant that covers most tuition at an Oregon community college for recent high school graduates and GED recipients. Grants are for students entering a community college in Oregon in Fall 2017. Funding for Oregon Promise for the 2017-2018 academic year is subject to Oregon Legislative approval.

### You may qualify if you:

- Graduate from an Oregon high school or complete the GED by August 1, 2017
- Have a 2.5 cumulative high school GPA or higher
- Have been an Oregon resident for at least 12 months prior to attending community college

### Steps to take:

- Apply by July 3, 2017 at 5pm PDT** if you will begin college in Fall 2017.
  - Complete the Oregon Promise Application at [OregonStudentAid.gov](http://OregonStudentAid.gov)
  - Verify your GPA or GED in the application
  - File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Oregon Student Aid Application (ORSAA) and list at least one Oregon community college
- Once approved, **Enroll in and Attend** an Oregon community college at least half time (6 credits minimum) within six months of graduating high school or completing the GED and accept all state and federal grants

If you do not qualify for this grant, talk to your school's financial aid office to explore the many other ways to afford your college goals.
